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BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS OF NANYUKI MUNICIPAL BOARD

HELD ON 22ND JANUARY 2026

The Nanyuki Municipal Board convened on 22nd January 2026 to review progress on key initiatives, address citizen concerns, and plan for upcoming development programs. The meeting focused on public engagement outcomes, program preparations, and the operationalization of transferred functions.

Public Engagement Forum

The Board reviewed the quarterly Public Engagement Forum held on 15th January 2026, where residents raised important concerns regarding municipal services and land rates valuation.

Key Actions:

- Follow-up with the Infrastructure Department on the valuation roll matter to address residents' concerns about land rates calculations
- Engagement with Meru County on a Memorandum of Agreement for solid waste collection from Makutano Junction

KUSP II and APA II Preparations

The Board reviewed preparations for the Kenya Urban Support Programme Phase II (KUSP II) and the Annual Performance Assessment Phase II (APA II). With assessments scheduled for February, the Board prioritized meeting minimum requirements.

Priority Actions:

- Preparation of a detailed status report comparing required assessment conditions against current position
- Request to Revenue Board for allocation of own-source revenue including land rates and business permits
- Escalation of key Board affairs concerns to the Executive level for urgent resolution

Operationalization of Transferred Functions

The Board expressed concern over the incomplete operationalization of certain transferred functions that directly impact residents' quality of life.

Areas Requiring Attention:

- **Street Lighting System** – Ensuring consistent operation and maintenance throughout the municipality

- **Emergency Response Services** – Full activation and readiness of emergency services within municipal boundaries

The Manager has been directed to engage relevant departments to ensure effective operationalization of these critical services.

Committee Recommendations

The Board reviewed and approved recommendations from all committee meetings. Implementation will proceed subject to the availability of funding, ensuring prudent financial management while advancing municipal priorities.

Municipality Calendar of Events

The Board approved the Municipality's Calendar of Events for 2026, highlighting key community engagement and environmental initiatives:

- **Nanyuki Municipal River Cleaning Day** – 14th March 2026
- **Nanyuki Municipal Prayer Day** – 20th March 2026
- **Nanyuki Municipal Marathon Day** – 25th August 2026
- **Nanyuki Municipal Non-motorized day**- 3rd November 2026

These events reflect our commitment to environmental stewardship, community wellness, and social cohesion. We invite all residents to participate and make these initiatives successful.

Governance and Accountability

The Board reinforced its commitment to transparency and accountability through several governance improvements:

- All pending Board resolutions to be concluded before the next meeting
- Standardization of correspondence with appropriate reference numbers for better tracking
- Introduction of tabulated reports showing actions taken on Board decisions
- Boardroom renovation to enhance the working environment for effective deliberations
